Chief Martinez provided insight into the consolidation of the Elgin & McDade Volunteer Firefighters - confirming the ESD response area now has 24/7- 365 coverage.

CHIEF'S REPORT

Chief Noble provided updates about the new Police Department and where the process is currently, along with the tentative date for building site mobilization.

NEW BUSINESS
