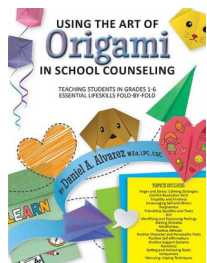

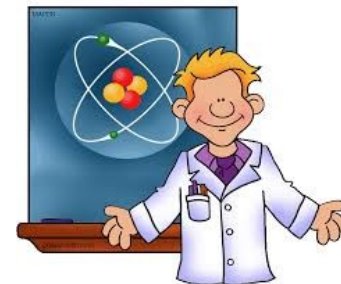

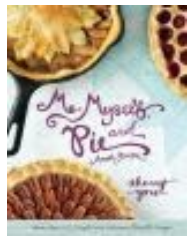


## PI (PIE) DAY POTLUCK
