



## The 2023-2024 Elgin Street Resurfacing Program

November 15, 2023

The Elgin City Council has made a commitment each year to dedicate certain funding to the Repair and upkeep of Elgin City Streets. This year the council has approved a street list that focuses on repairs and resurfacing on the East side of town in Wards 1 and 4. These improvements include asphalt overlay of deteriorating streets as well as new concrete valley gutters and drainage improvements. A list of streets designated for repair in the 2023 season is below.

The list for improvements is as follows and in order of staff's recommendation for improvements.

- E. 3<sup>rd</sup> St. from N Ave F. to the dead end (Ward 4) 343 LF.
- Ave J from 2<sup>nd</sup> St. to Q.S. Goins (Ward 4) 1,167 LF.
- Depot Street from Ave B. Ave C. (Downtown Improvement) 326 LF.
- Ave B from Depot to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. (Downtown Improvement) 682 LF
- Zaragoza Street in its Entirety (Ward 1) 763 LF
- Monterrey From 201 Monterrey to FM1704 (Ward 1 and a thoroughfare) 875 LF
- Old McDade Rd, From the Y at Brenham St. to MLK (Ward 4) 690 LF
- E. 1<sup>st</sup> Street from Main to the Railroad tracks. (Ward 4) 220 LF
- Ave G from 2<sup>nd</sup> street to 4<sup>th</sup> street. (Ward 4) 690 LF
- N Ave E from Lexington Rd then to East 7<sup>th</sup> to N Ave F. (Ward 4) 760 LF.

Recommended by City Staff for chip seal:

- Elgin Meadows Subdivision in its entirety, this includes 4 streets. (Ward 3) 4,927 LF.

Recommended by City Staff for curb and gutter, drainage inlets and pavement:

- Ave C storm inlet. 2 places (Ward 4)
- E. 1<sup>st</sup> Street inlets at the railroad tracks. (Ward 4)
- Church Street at MLK to include a new valley gutter. (Ward 1)
